- 19) Freedom - that they are released from the bondage of insecurities, temptations, and fears.
 - 20) Forgiveness - that they understand the value of forgiving others.
- 21) Role as children - that they understand the role of their parents and are respectfully obedient to them.
 - 22) Pressures/trials - that the pressures they feel don't overwhelm them or crush their spirit.
 - 23) Peace - that God will grant them peace and the ability to enjoy life.
- 24) Future spouse - that God sends the right person into their lives to help them live Godly lives.
 - 25) Health - that God protects and strengthens him physically, mentally, and emotionally.
 - 26) Provision - that God provides for their needs even the ones we don't see.
